Dear Grade One/Two Parents,

As part of our Science unit about living things, and Social Studies unit on the importance of the cedar tree to the First Nations people, we have been caring for cedar seedlings. Now we will be going on a field trip to plant them in the woods. On **Tuesday, October 16**, we will be joining other classes in the community, to learn more about cedars and plant our seedlings up Duck Lake Road. We will leave the school at 9:15 and return at approximately 11:00. We will travel by school bus. No uniforms are required on this day. **Please ensure that your child dresses appropriately for a walk in the woods – no flip flops/sandals. Dress for the weather. Your child may bring a small shovel or garden spade to help plant his/her tree.** Although your child will be fully supervised, injuries such as twisted ankles, cuts and bruises may occur.
