Devices

A reminder to students and parents of our 'Bring Your Own Device' policy. While personal devices are permitted for educational use in some classrooms, depending on a discussion with the teacher, misuse of these devices can lead to a student's permission being revoked.



Our policy states:

"Devices operated during instructional time are to be used for educational purposes only. Staff members will determine if the use is acceptable or not. Devices operated during non-instructional time are to be used for appropriate communication and will be subject to review at any time by a staff member."

Students should not be using devices on the bus, especially to take photos or videos of their peers. If students are engaging in behaviours like these, there is a diminished expectation of privacy for the content on their device, and a staff member may request to see what is on the device. If you permit your child to have a device, please review these appropriate use guidelines with them.
